LCDC nominees to the Dublin Rural Leader Local Action Group (LAG) have met on a number of occasions during the months of May, June and July to further develop and submit a strengthened LEADER Local Development Strategy. The Independent Selection Committee (ISC) of the <u>Department</u> of Arts, Heritage, Regional, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs approved the strategy on August 11<sup>th</sup>.

### 2.0 SOCIAL INCLUSION COMMUNITY ACTIVATION PROGRAMME (SICAP)

The SICAP Oversight Sub Committee have met on four occasions to date, most recently in early July to conduct a Mid-Year Review. The Mid-Year review process noted the SICAP Programme Implementer (PI), Blanchardstown Area Partnership achieved both of its mid-year Key performance Indicators. LCDC members identified a number of specific areas where additional progress by the PI is required to meet headline targets by years end. The sub-committee is working within a supportive framework with the PI to enable this to take place.

LCDC members attended Pobal training over these last few months on targeting hard to reach groups, conducting Mid-Year Reviews and In September, some members will attend an event on how SICAP services can support women experiencing domestic abuse and men who are at risk of suicide.
