THE LEGACY OF THE RISING AND THE BATTLE OF ASHBOURNE

The part that Fingal played in the fight for Irish freedom is a unique story that needs to be told. In order to honour the role of the men and women of Fingal in the events of 1916, and share this story, the Council has compiled a broad programme for the Fingal 1916 Centenary Commemoration.

The Battle of Ashbourne involved men and women from the Fifth Battalion (the Fingal Brigade) and was one of the only military successes of the Easter Rising. Several prominent surnames that feature in the events of 1916 including Ashe, Mulcahy, Coleman, Kettle, Wilson, Weston, Kelly, McAllister, Adrien, Fleming and Lawless to name but a few, are synonymous with Fingal and many of the families remain here today.

In the aftermath of the Rising, almost 150 Fingallians were arrested and sent to internment camps, such as Frongoch, in Wales. These included members of the Fingal Brigade. Most were not released until June 1917. Despite the reaction to events immediately after The Rising, they were given a warm reception.

Mindful of this heritage, Fingal County Council have reached out to the relatives of those involved, members of the Fingal Old IRA Commemorative Society, historical societies, community groups, artists and the wider public to collaborate on delivering a diverse and rich programme of events that honours this legacy. Piecing the story together and presenting it through a variety of media and from differing perspectives will allow us to secure its place in the memory of future generations.

Chun urraim a thabhairt don ról a bhí ag fir agus ag mná Fine Gall in imeachtaí 1916, agus chun a scéal a roinnt, tá an Chomhairle tar éis clár leathan do Chomóradh Céad Blaín 1916 Fine Gall a chur le chéile.

Bhí fir agus mná ón gCúigiú Cathlán (Cathlán Fine Gall) páirteach i gCath Chill Dhéaglán a bhí ar cheann de chorr bhua míleata Éirí Amach na Cásca. Ar roinnt de na sloinnte iomráiteacha a thagann chun cinn in imeachtaí 1916 áiritear Ághas (Ashe), Ó Maolchatha (Mulcahy), Ó Colmáin (Coleman), Kettle, Wilson, Weston, Ó Ceallaigh (Kelly), McAllister, Adrien, Fleming agus Laighléis (Lawless), sloinntte atá comhchiallach le Fine Gall agus tá cuid mhaith de na teaghláigh sin anseo go fóill sa lá atá inniu ann.

I ndiaidh an Éirí Amach gabhadh beagnach 150 de mhuintir Fine Gall agus cuireadh chuig campáí géibhinn iad, mar Fhrongach sa Bhreatain Bheag. Bhí baill de Chathlán Fine Gall ina measc siúd. Níor scoaileadh saor a bhformhór go dtí Meitheamh 1917. Ainneoin na freagartha d'imeachtaí díreach ina dhiadair, cuireadh fáilte chroíúil rompu.

Agus iad ar an eolas faoin oidhreacht seo, tá Comhairle Contae Fine Gall tar éis dul i gcomhar le gaolta na ndaoine a bhí rannpháirteach, le baill de Chumann Cuimhneacháin Fine Gall den SeanIRA, cumainn stairiúla, grúpaí pobail, ealaíontóirí agus leis an bpobal níos leithne le clár saibhir éagsúil imeachtaí a sheachadadh le hurrainn a thabhairt don oidhreacht seo. Tríd an scéal a chur le chéile ina chodanna agus é a chur i láthair trí mheáin éagsúla ceadóidh sé seo dúinn áit a chinntí dó i gcuimhne na nglúnta atá le teacht.

FINGAL'S COMMEMORATIVE PROGRAMME

Within the Council, an interdepartmental working group and the Fingal 1916 Centenary Commemoration Steering Committee have worked closely to ensure that the programme spans all areas of our remit. The programme is the result of a countywide partnership with key stakeholders that has been devised to reflect on and commemorate Fingal's unique heritage.

The Council aspires to support the strong willingness to engage in commemorating the role played by Fingallians in the events of 1916, which is evident among our community. To this end we will support individuals and groups to run events and projects as part of the Centenary Commemoration through the Centenary Fund. Information events conducted with the public to raise awareness of the availability of the fund and to consult with the community on the programme assisted in identifying priorities for the Fingal 1916 Centenary Commemoration. Involving young people and having an inclusive, collaborative, county wide events programme underpinned by the Irish language emerged as aspects of key importance to the community.

In response the council will deliver and support a range of events specifically for young people, including those from our new communities, based around poetry, theatre, film, proclamation readings in Irish and English, commemorative tree planting ceremonies and historical re-enactments in schools. We will also support the network of community centres across the county in marking the Centenary at a local level.

The community will be invited to engage in the Centenary Commemorations in Fingal, across all seven programme strands, through events like the Fingal Memorabilia Days, which will be held in Autumn 2015. Relatives and the public will be invited to contribute and share stories, artefacts, photos of their connections to the unique story of Fingal and the pivotal role played by Fingallians in the fight for Irish freedom in 1916. The recorded information will be available as part of the legacy of the Fingal Centenary in an on-line archive to honour those involved and raise the profile of the national significance of the pivotal role of Fingal in these events for future generations.

CLÁR COMÓRTHA FHINE GALL

D'oibrigh meitheal idir-rannach agus coiste stiúrtha Chomóradh Céad Blaín 1916 Fine Gall le chéile go dlúth laistigh den Chomhairle le cinntí go gelúdaíonn an clár ár sainréimsí uile. Is toradh é an clár ar chomhpháirtíocht le príomhpháirtithe leasmhara ar fud an chontae a ceapadh chun léiriú a thabhairt ar oidhreacht uathúil Fine Gall agus í a chomóradh. Tá sé d'aídham ag an gComhairle tacú leis an bhfonn láidir a bheith ranpháirteach i gcomóradh an ról a bhí ag muintir Fine Gall in imeachtaí 1916, ar léir go soiléir é i measc an phobail anseo. Chuige seo tacóimid le daoine aonair agus le grúpaí imeachtaí agus tionscadail a réachtáil mar chuid den Chomóradh Céad Blaín trí Chiste an Chéid. Chuidigh imeachtaí eolais a réachtálach leis an bpobal chun feasacht a spreagadh ar infhaighteacht an chiste agus chun dul i gcomhairle leis an bpobal ar an gclár chun tosaíochtaí a athint do Chomóradh Céad Blaín 1916 Fine Gall. Tháinig sé chun cinn gur ghnéithe a raibh tábhacht lárnoch leo don phobal iad ranpháirtíocht daoine óga agus clár imeachtaí comhoibríoch agus cuimsitheach a bheith ann ar fud an chontae leis an nGaeilge mar bhonntaca aige.

Dá bharr seo tacóidh an Chomhairle le raon imeachtaí do dhaoine óga go sonrach agus déanfaidh iad a sheachadadh, lena n-áirítear iad siúd ón bpobail nua, bunaithe ar philíocht, ar an amharclann, ar scannáin, ar léamha an phorógra i nGaeilge agus i mbÉarla, ar shearmanais chomórtha chur crann agus ar ath-achtuithe stairiúla i scoileanna. Tacóimid freisin leis an líonra d'ionaid phobail ar fud na tíre agus an Comóradh Céad Blaín á cheiliúradh acu ag leibhéal áitiúil.

Tabharfar cuireadh don phobal a bheith ranpháirteach sna himeachtaí Comórtha Céad Blaín i bhFine Gall, thar na seacht stráth cláir uile, trí imeachtaí ar nós Laethanta Earraí Cuimhneacháin Fine Gall, a réachtálfar i bhFómhar 2015. Tabharfar cuireadh do ghaolta agus don phobal scéalta, déantáin, grianghraif dá naisc le scéal uathúil Fine Gall agus an ról ríthábhachtach a bhí ag muintir Fine Gall sa troid ar son saoirse na hÉireann i 1916, a chur isteach agus a chomhroinnt. Beidh an t-eolas taifeadta ar fáil mar chuid d'oidhreacht Chéad Blaín Fine Gall i gcartann

As well as the diverse programme of events specifically developed for the Centenary many of our established programmes will reflect the commemoration theme. *Memory Makers*, a popular annual programme which encourages people over 55 to reflect on a moment special to them that can be represented through various craft media, will focus on memories of the 1916 Centenary. *Flavours of Fingal*, the County Show which celebrates Fingal's rich agricultural heritage and local food production, took place in June 2015 and 65,000 people attended. Re-enactors from the Old IRA and Irish Military Living History in uniform promoted the upcoming Fingal Memorabilia Days and raised awareness of the upcoming programme. It is intended to mark the Commemoration during the 2016 event.

The programme will culminate in the Fingal 1916 Centenary Commemorative Day. This flagship event will take place at Swords Castle and will incorporate a parade, re-enactments, marching bands, an exhibition, reading of the Proclamation, flag raising and launching of the public arts commission. A highlight of the event will be Rothafocht na mBan, a cycle of a group of women in period costume, to commemorate the contribution of women in Fingal to the events of 1916. Many of the messages delivered to the volunteers would have been by bicycle, often by a female messenger, such as Mary (Molly) Adrien who delivered dispatches from PH Pearse in the GPO to Thomas Ashe in the Swords area. This event will mark the culmination of all of the consultation and collaboration between the Council, Fingal Old IRA Commemorative Society, the relatives and the wider Fingal community in commemorating Fingal's Role in the Rising.

Reáchtáladh Blasanna Fine Gall, an Seó Contae a cheiliúrann oidhreacht talmhaóchta shaibhir agus táirgeadh bia áitiúil Fine Gall, i Meitheamh 2015 agus d'fhreastail 65,000 duine air. Rinne ath-achtóirí ó SeanIRA agus ó Stair Bheo Mhíleata na hÉireann faoi éide bolscaireacht do Laethanta Earráí Cuimhneacháin Fine Gall atá ag teacht aníos agus chuir le feasacht ar an gclár atá ag teacht aníos. Tá sé ceaptha an Comóradh a cheiliúradh i rith imeachta 2016.

Tabharfar an clár chun críche ar Lá Comórtha Céad Bliain 1916 Fine Gall. Tionólfar an imeacht suaitheanta seo ag Caisleán Shoir agus ionchorprófar ann paráid, ath-achtuithe, bannai máirseála, taispeántais, léamh an Fhorógra, ardú bratacha agus seoladh an choimisiúin ealaíon phoiblí. Ar cheann de mhórimeachtaí an imeachta beidh Rothafocht na mBan, grúpa ban in éadaí na linne ag rothaócht chun rannchuidiú mná Fine Gall in imeachtaí 1916 a chomóradh. Is ar rothair a dhéanfaí cuid mhór de na teachtaireachtaí a sheachadadh chuíg na hóláigh, teachtaire baineann go minic, mar Mary (Molly) Adrien a d'iompair seoltaí ó Phádraig Mac Piarais in Ardofig an Phoist go Thomas Ashe i gceantar Shoir. Beidh an imeacht seo mar chríoch ar an gcomhairliúchán agus ar an geomhoibriú go léir idir an Chomhairle, Cumann Comórtha SeanIRA Fine Gall, na gaolta agus ról níos leithne Fine Gall i geomóradh phobal Fine Gall san Éirí Amach.

- Project culminating in a celebratory event and three-month exhibition from April to June 2016, which may then tour countywide.

- A lecture series with Des McGuinness on the impact of 1916 on visual art practice.
