



Test Dig on Plots – Guide Lines

- 1) The legal owner must give a letter stating that they give Fingal Council permission to carry out a test dig on there family plot.
- 2) The letter should state the Burial Ground, Plot Number and any relevant interment names, dates etc. A diagram of where the plot is situated if it is not clearly marked by a number or headstone.
- 3) If the legal owner of the plot is deceased the next of kin must give permission for the test dig to be carried out.
- 4) The cost for a test dig to be carried out is €550.00 + 23% VAT (€676.50). The cheque should be made payable to “Fingal County Council” and forwarded to Howth/Malahide Operations Division, Grove Road, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15.
- 5) The Council will write out to the applicant with the test results. These results will state if any further burials can take place. The Councils decision is final.
