

The Burrow, Portrane, Circa 1910












Proposed Approach to Coastal Flooding & Erosion in The Burrow, Portrane

Flooding

- Brief the Fingal Coastal Liaison
 Group (CLG) on general condition
 of existing Coastal Defences at
 Donabate.
- Survey exact location/extent of existing Sheet Metal Revetment
- Commission study in consultation with (CLG) to determine adequacy of revetment or need to extend or reinforce the structure to prevent flooding at The Burrow

Erosion

Commission study in consultation with relevant national agencies to provide a best practice approach to deal with Coastal Erosion in sites including those which are the subject of a Habitats and/or Birds Directive designation (with specific reference to Portrane)



Process for Addressing Coastal Erosion Policy Deficiencies

Early 2016 FCC requested setting up of Coastal Erosion Working Group by City & County Manager's Association (CCMA)

CCMA Climate Change Sub-Committee establishes Coastal Erosion Working Group

Working Group Commissions Audits of Coastal Erosion related Policies and Practices involving 19 Coastal Local Authorities

Consultants will analyse Audit Information and prepare report.
