



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

HORESTOWN ROAD, TYRRELSTOWN,

LUSK, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order temporarily closing Horestown Road, Tyrrelstown, Lusk, Co Dublin, following an application from ESB Networks to facilitate ESB works. It is proposed the road will be closed from **9.00am to 6.00pm from 1st October 2019 until 18th October 2019.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:-

Residents South West of Works – Diversion R127 heading North towards Collinstown/Balcullin area which connect to the R1285. Alternatively, traffic can take the R128 heading East towards Whitestown/Lower Main Street Rush

Residents North West of Works – Diversion to the R128 heading East towards Baldongan. Alternatively traffic can take the R127 heading South towards Great Common/Lusk Town.

Residents South East of Works – Diversion to the R128 heading north towards Ballustree/Ballykea area. Alternatively traffic can take the R128 heading west towards Lusk.

Residents North East of Works – Diversion to the R1285 heading East towards Balcunnin. Alternatively traffic can take the R128 heading South with connects Rush to Lusk.

Local access only to be provided for the residents of Raheny & Ballykea Roads.
