• we have created a social story for the event with information about what happens at the book clinic and about the space where the book clinic will take place

so that parents, guardians and children can make an informed choice about whether to attend.

• we endeavour to offer appointments in advance at these clinics, to reduce waiting times for families.

Of course, our book doctors aren't real medical doctors! While they are not experts in autism or literacy, they are children's books experts, with incredible knowledge and heaps of brilliant book recommendations at their fingertips. They will always try to find the very best book for every child, tailored to the child's interests so that they can discover the joy of reading and books, whether they are reading themselves or being read to".
