



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015– SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RAILWAY STREET, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Gas Networks Ireland, for permission to temporarily close **Railway Street, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin**, to facilitate a gas connection. It is proposed the road will be closed from **10.00pm to 6.00am on Monday 9th December 2019 until Thursday 12th December 2019**.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Motorists travelling from George Hill will have no access to Railway Street and will need to continue straight to Drogheda Street.

Local access only to Railway Street from Drogheda Street to the train station.

Traffic from Convent Lane will come under brought to one lane.

Note access to carpark for Supervalu's and apartments will be maintained with a turn from Drogheda Street onto convent lane under an all stop on Convent Lane.
