



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015- SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRACKENSTOWN ROAD, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from John McQuillan (Contracts) Ltd, for permission to temporarily close Brackenstown Road, Swords, Co. Dublin, to facilitate road resurfacing works being carried out on behalf of Fingal County Council.
