NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD CARRICKBRACK ROAD, HOWTH, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close Old Carrickbrack Road, Howth, Co. Dublin, following an application from John Cradock Ltd. on behalf of Irish Water.

The purpose of this closure is for the installation of a 280mm diameter watermain.

The period of the temporary closure will be from **8.00am Monday, 9th March 2020 until 18.00pm Friday, 27th March 2020.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative route for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure is as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
Toward Sutton - on the Windgate Road	Sutton	Continue on the Windgate Road to the junction with Carrickbrack Road (R105)
Toward Howth - on the Windgate Road	Howth	Continue on the Windgate Road -Windgate Rise- Balkill Road until the junction with Carrickbrack Road (R105)

Local access will be provided over the period of the closure.
