TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES
HOWTH MALAHIDE OPERATIONAL AREA

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transportation Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared a Scheme for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:

- Strand Road, Sutton, Co. Dublin. – 1 No. Traffic Calming Ramp & 1 Set of Traffic Calming Speed Cushions.
- Back Road, at Castlefield Malahide, Co. Dublin. – 1 No. Traffic Calming Table Top Ramp.
- Station Road, Portmarnock, Co. Dublin. – 2 Sets of Traffic Calming Speed Cushions.

These schemes include the provision of traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary.
