



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRACKENSTOWN ROAD AND CHURCH ROAD, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order temporarily closing close Brackenstown Road and Church Road, Swords, Co. Dublin, to facilitate the installation of a watermain. It is proposed that the road will be closed for 24hrs from **26th October 2020 until 30th November 2020**. The road is closed 24 hours, the permitted working hours shall be between **08:30 and 19:30 Monday-Friday and 10:00 and 17:00 Saturday**.

Two submissions were received during the consultation period.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Light Goods Vehicles

- Traffic travelling from Brackenstown Road will follow the diversion to Brackenstown Avenue onto Rathbeale Road and continue to Bridge Street.
- Traffic travelling from Bridge Street will follow diversion to Rathbeale Road onto Brackenstown Avenue and continue to Brackenstown Road.

Heavy Good Vehicles

- Traffic travelling from Brackenstown Road will follow the diversion to St Cronans Avenue onto Rathbeale Road and continue to Bridge Street.
- Traffic travelling from Bridge Street will follow the diversion to Rathbeale Road onto St Cronans Avenue and continue to Brackenstown Road.
