

Parklet Partners

Fingal County Council Seeking “Parklet Partners”
to Provide New Parklets for Fingal.



Parklets convert a few on-street parking spaces (excluding accessible, age friendly and loading bay) into public open space and are a cost-effective way to create more vibrant streets, support local business, and provide an inviting space for residents and passers-by to dine and relax.

Who can apply?

Business owners and clusters of business owners in the county e.g. restaurant, coffee shop owners. Priority will be given to two or more adjacent businesses, regardless of business type, working together.

Partner's Responsibilities

Fingal County Council will fund and install the basic parklet. The “Parklet Partner” will be responsible for the day-to-day upkeep of the parklet and the insurance of the parklet. The council parklet is a decked area, all extras: tables / chairs, canopies etc. are the responsibility of the businesses to provide.

How long will the parklets be in place?

Parklets will initially be in place for one year. After a year, they will be evaluated to consider whether they should be kept in place for another year, replaced with more permanent seating, or moved to a new location.
