



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75**

### **NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHAPEL ROAD, KINSEALY, CO. DUBLIN.**

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Chapel Road, Kinsealy, Co. Dublin** following an application from BSG Civil Engineering Ltd on behalf of Irish Water.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the installation of a deep gravity sewer.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **08.00 Thursday, 25th February 2021 until 18.00 Friday, 26th of February 2021.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative route for traffic travelling in the area during the closure is as follows:

<b>North or East bound</b> From Malahide Road (R107)	Drumnigh Road (R124), Portmarnock and Malahide	Moyne Road (R123), Drumnigh Road (R124), Station Road
<b>South or West bound</b> From Malahide/Baldoyle	Drumnigh Road (R124), and Malahide Road	Moyne Road (R123) Drumnigh Road (R124) - Station Road

Local access will be provided over the period of the closure.
