CONDITIONS

Applications are invited by Fingal County Council for concessions to operate stands for the sale of refreshments for the Summer Season 2021 at the public beaches listed in the Application Form attached to this document. The location of the pitches on the beaches is as indicated on the drawings; **227/2D; 227/3D; 227/4D; 227/5D; 227/6D; 227/7D.**

In all cases **Pitch No.1** is the pitch nearest the access or entrances onto the beach and the remainder being further from the entrance.

The following conditions shall apply:

1. Applications must be completed & submitted on the Application Form enclosed.
2. All stands must be of moveable units suitably equipped for the particular service, which it is proposed to provide. Under no circumstances will concessionaires be allowed to operate from private or other motor cars. No makeshift or aesthetically unsuitable structures/units will be allowed. **Vehicles towing catering facilities, in particular, must have sufficient horsepower to enable them to tow said facilities, whilst on the beach area.**
3. **Concessionaires will not be allowed to trade on the beaches concerned before 11.00 a.m. and all moveable stands must be removed from the beaches before 8.00 p.m. each night.** Units/stands may not be left without a traction vehicle except with the expressed approval of the Council's Official.
4. All concessionaires will be required to provide not less than two **Litter Receptacles** in respect of each stand and at the end of each day must collect all paper, plastic and glass litter within a 20metre radius of their stand. Failure on behalf of the Concessionaires to meet this requirement may result in the cancellation of the concession without refund of the fee paid to the Council for said seasonal concession.
5. The area to be taken up by any one stand, including storage of goods and **Litter Receptacles**, is to be not more than **15 square metres**. Stands will only be located within the general area indicated on the map supplied & must be agreed on-site with a Council Official, **the stands must remain at the agreed location for the duration of the season.**
6. **Public Liability Insurance in the amount of €6.5m** in the case of any one accident must be obtained, **the policy must state that Fingal County Council is indemnified**, and the applicant must give proof of it to the Council before any concession is granted.
7. **Certificate of Motor Insurance and a Certificate of Roadworthiness** must be supplied in respect of the relevant vehicle where appropriate.

8. Each stand/unit must be maintained in a neat, tidy and hygienic manner. The use of stands for the sale of refreshments must comply with the **Food Hygiene Regulations** on default of which the Concessionaire may be liable to suffer the prescribed penalties as well as possible cancellation of the concession and forfeiture of the fee paid to the Council for said seasonal concession.
9. **Health & Safety Statements** complying with the guidelines of the **Health and Safety Authority** available from HSE must be forwarded with the Application. This must also demonstrate that you are compliant with Covid-19 guidelines.
10. All Concessionaires must abide by the Bye-Laws governing the said beaches (available on www.fingal.ie) as well as the conditions attached to each concession and any breach of same may result in the withdrawal of the concession granted without refund of fee or part thereof.
11. Each Concession will be valid from **Saturday 24th April 2021 to Sunday 26th September 2021.**
12. It should be noted that the access to Rush North, Rush South, Donabate, Portmarnock are controlled by gates and access to the other beaches are controlled by height restriction barriers. Gates & barriers must be securely locked immediately after use. Concessionaires will be issued with keys to the gates or barriers on payment of a deposit and will be made responsible for such keys to ensure that no unauthorised traders/persons will be able to gain access to the beaches using those keys. Keys must be returned to the Council at the end of the concession period at which time the deposit will be refunded. Failure to return a key at the end of the season may result in future applications being refused.
13. Sale of inflatable beds and rings are prohibited.
14. Concessionaires are to comply with the instructions from Fingal County Council's Officials and may only trade at the pitch allocated.
15. Trading pitches will be assigned to successful applicants by Public Lottery. Successful applicants will be notified in writing of the time and date of the Lottery.
