The Yeats family were one of the most significant creative families active in Ireland prior to and after the formation of the State. This illustrated lecture documents the achievements of the Yeats family



from early childhood, through to the 1880s when siblings William, Susan and Elizabeth were studying together at the Dublin Metropolitan School of Art (now the National College of Art and Design). It follows their fragmented education and examines the different career paths they pursued and their many remarkable achievements.
