- Employment Detail Summary and *Statement of Liability* for 2020 for each member of the household employed, for each employment held during the year, available via *My Account* on *Revenue.ie*
- Proof of **Start** or **Cease Date** if you changed job or are no longer employed, available via *My Account* on *Revenue.ie*
- Pay and Tax Details Year to Date** for a new job available via *My Account* on *Revenue.ie*

- Current Notice of Assessment from the Tax Office.

PERSON MOVING IN TO THE HOUSE, INCOME DETAILS AND THE DATE THAT PERSON MOVED IN MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THIS RENT ASSESSMENT FORM:

- If a person has moved in, that person's income will be assessed for the weekly charge, this does not infer a right to reside. A separate request for permission to reside must be made in writing to the Estate Management section.

PERSON MOVING OUT OF HOUSE/ REMOVE PERSON FROM RENT, DETAILS OF NEW ADDRESS AND DATE MOVED OUT TO BE INCLUDED WTH THIS FORM:
