## NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF BACK ROAD, MALAHIDE, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close a section of Back Road, Malahide, Co. Dublin, following an application from John Cradock Ltd. on behalf of Irish Water.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the installation of a combination of power cables and a 400mm piped watermain.

The road will be closed at the Railway Bridge, between Castlefield Manor and the Demesne Carpark from 08.00 Monday, 10th May to 17.00 Monday, 17th May 2021.

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:
