



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF BACK ROAD, MALAHIDE, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close a section of Back Road, Malahide, Co. Dublin, following an application from John Cradock Ltd. on behalf of Irish Water.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the installation of a combination of power cables and a 400mm piped watermain.

The road will be closed at the Railway Bridge, between Castlefield Manor and the Demesne Carpark **from 08.00 Monday, 10th May to 17.00 Monday, 17th May 2021.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
Travelling East from the R107/ Back Road Junction	Castlefield Manor, Back Road	Malahide Road (R107/106) via Malahide Village – R124 Drumnigh Road – Back Road
Travelling West from Castlefield Manor/Back Road	The R107/ Back Road Junction	Via the R124 Drumnigh Road, through Malahide Village and Malahide Road (R106/R107) – Dublin direction to the Back Road Junction

Local access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure and access open to the Demesne Carpark from the R107 Malahide Road / Back Road junction only.
