

ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN SKERRIES, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order temporarily closing roads in the Skerries area for the purpose of holding a Triathlon race. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from **9.00am to 13.00pm** Sunday 5th September 2021.

The roads in question are:-

- Red Island to Harbour Road.
- · Harbour Road to Quay Street.
- Quay Street to Hoar Rock.
- Hoar Rock to White Cottages.
- Portion of Skerries to Balbriggan Road (R127) from "the White Cottages" to Hampton Cove.

Alternative routes available for traffic (No HGVs. See HGV diversion below) are as follows:-

Access from Skerries to Balbriggan:

- R127 to the junction of the L1275/Blackhills, signposted Ardgillan Castle.
- Turn right onto L1275/Blackhills and follow the road north.
- At the T-Junction facing Ardgillan Castle entrance take the left turn on to the Barnageeragh Road (Baltrasna).
- Take the right turn at the T-Junction onto Rosepark (Darcytown Road) and follow the road towards Balrothery.
- At the junction take a right on to the Balrothery Drogheda Road (Coach Road).
- Follow the Coach Road to the junction of the R132.
- Take the right turn onto the R132.

***HGVs – follow signs: divert via R128 (Loughshinny) and R127 (Lusk), then R132 northbound to Balbriggan.

Access from Balbriggan to Skerries:

- Take the R132 to Balrothery.
- Take the left turn, signposted Ardgillan Park.
- Take the Coach Road to the junction with Rosepark.
- Take a left on to Rosepark (Darcytown Road) and continue to junction signposted Ardgillan Castle.
- Take the left turn on to the Barnageeragh (Baltrasna) Road.
- Continue to the entrance of Ardgillan Castle and take the right turn at the T-Junction, on to the L1275/Blackhills.
- Follow the L1275 to the R127 and take a left.

***HGVs – follow signs: divert via R132 (southbound) then take the R127 to Lusk and R128 (Loughshinny) to Skerries.

No access from Balbriggan to Skerries via R127.

No access from Lusk to Skerries via R127.

Access to Ardgillan via R132 and Balrothery, Rosepark (Darcystown Road).

Local access, pedestrian and emergency vehicles will be facilitated by local marshals.

Diversion signage and marshals will be in place for the duration of the closure.
