



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF BALSADDEN ROAD, HOWTH, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close Balscadden Road, Howth, Co. Dublin between the East Pier junction and Kilrock Road junction.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate sewer network maintenance.

The road will be closed from **Wednesday, 10th November 2021 from 08.00hrs until 18.00hrs.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:

| Direction of Travel | Destination | Alternative Routes |
|----------------------------|--|--|
| Eastbound | Balscadden Cliff Car Park/ Howth Head | Via Abbey Street and Thormanby Road (R105) onto Nashville Road and Kilrock Road. |
| Westbound | Howth Village | No change from existing route. |

Local access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure.
