



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD CARRICKBRACK ROAD, HOWTH, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close Old Carrickbrack Road, Howth, Co. Dublin from its junction with Ceanchor Road/Carrickbrack Road to the junction of Windgate Road.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the the installation of a new water main on behalf of Irish Water.

The road will be closed from **09.00 Monday, 13th June 2022 to 17.00 on Monday, 22nd August 2022.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:

| Direction of Travel | Destination | Alternative Routes |
|----------------------------|--------------------|---|
| Toward Windgate Road | Windgate Road | Carrickbrack Road and Old Carrickbrack Road |
| From Windgate Road | Carrickbrack Road | Old Carrickbrack Road |

Local access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure as well as pedestrian and cycleway access.
