



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAUDERS LANE, SUTTON, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close Lauders Lane, Sutton, Co. Dublin.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate resurfacing works by the railway crossing on behalf of Irish Rail.

It is proposed that the road lane will be closed from **19.00 on Saturday, 11th June 2022 to 12.00 midday on Sunday, 12th of June 2022.**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative route for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure is as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
Station Road to Burrow Road	Burrow Road	Sutton Cross to Howth Road. Cross Railway Line at Claremont Road onto Burrow Road Towards Lauders Lane
Burrow Road to Station Road	Station Road	Cross the Railway Line at Claremont Road to Howth Road and to Station Road via Sutton Cross

Pedestrian and cycleway access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure

Local access will be provided over the proposed road closure.
