



To each participating group of Balbriggan St Patrick's Day Parade 2023

Assembly Point Time – 10am

Assembly and Surrounding Roads Close 11:30am (Groups must be signed in by this time.)

Assembly Point Location:

Pedestrian Assembly Point- Bremore Castle Car Park

Hybrid and Electric Vehicles Assembly Point- Drogheda St/ Lambreecher Junction (Only hybrid and electric vehicles permitted to take part in the parade.)

Pedestrian groups:

On Arrival:

- Leaders/Chaperones must check in at Registration on arrival and check in their group.
- You will be asked to lead your group to zone 1,2,3,4 or 5 inside the car park, which will be signposted.
- Each zone will have a marshal assigned to it who will answer any questions you may have.
- Your zone marshal will alert you when it is time for your group to leave assembly and begin marching.
- Please keep your group together and in the correct zone or you may miss your call.

Weather:

- Please prepare for the weather! Keep an eye on the forecast and advise your groups accordingly.

Personal Property:

- We do not have a facility to hold personal property. Please ensure you can carry your belongings with you. The assembly area will be closed and groups will not be able to return back to the assembly area to collect belongings afterwards so please don't leave anything behind!

Parade

Start time:

- Parade starts 12pm sharp.
- Assembly open from 10am, all groups must be signed in by 11:30am at the latest.

- **Electric/Hybrid vehicles:** continue to the Dublin St. roundabout at the church and onwards to their destination from there. Any vehicles that need to be made road safe can do so outside the church before continuing.

No throwing!

- We ask that there is no throwing of any kind from marching groups/vehicles into the crowd.
- No distribution of flyers/sweets allowed.
