

To each participating group of Malahide St Patrick's Day Parade 2023

Assembly Point Time - From 12.30pm

Assembly Close 1:30pm (Groups must be signed in by this time.) Road closure and diversion updates available on www.fingal.ie

Assembly Point Location:

Pedestrian Assembly Point - Access via Malahide Cricket Club

Drop-Off will be facilitated at Bridgefield Car Park – please arrive by foot or by bike where secure bike parking will be available. No car parking will be available.

Hybrid and Electric Vehicles Assembly Point at Bridgefield Car Park (Only hybrid and electric vehicles permitted to take part in the parade.)
As the parade is a live event some instructions may change on the day please follow the guidance of our stewards and volunteers

Pedestrian groups:

On Arrival:

- Leaders/Chaperones must check in at Registration on arrival and check in their group.
- You will be asked to lead your group to zone 1,2,3 or 4, which will be signposted.
- Each zone will have a marshal assigned to it who will answer any questions you may have.
- Your zone marshal will alert you when it is time for your group to leave assembly and begin marching.
- Please keep your group together and in the correct zone or you may miss your call.

Weather:

- Please prepare for the weather! Keep an eye on the forecast and advise your groups accordingly.

Personal Property:

- We do not have a facility to hold personal property. Please ensure you can carry your belongings with you. The assembly area will be closed and groups will not be able to return back to the assembly area to collect belongings afterwards so please don't leave anything behind!

Parade

Start time:

- Parade starts 2pm sharp.
- Assembly open from 12.30pm, all groups must be signed in by 1.30pm at the latest.

Route:

- Route Depart Assembly Area onto Malahide Road, Main Street, onto New Street and will finish on The Green at the Marina.

Disassembly Area:

- Pedestrian groups: The Green, Strand Street. Parents/guardians can collect their children here.
- Hybrid / EV Vehicles: will be directed towards St. James Terrace at finish where they
 can disband on the public road carefully. All vehicles must be made road safe before
 passing back onto the open road.

No throwing!

- We ask that there is no throwing of any kind from marching groups/vehicles into the crowd.
- No distribution of flyers/sweets allowed.
