



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75**

### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF KILROCK ROAD, HOWTH, CO. DUBLIN**

Fingal County Council has made an order for the temporary road closure of **Kilrock Road, Howth, Co. Dublin**, following an application from GMC Utilities Group Ltd, on behalf of Gas Networks Ireland.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate domestic gas servicing.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Tuesday 21st March 2023**.

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes available for traffic during the proposed closure hours are as follows:
