

# Seatown Road to Estuary Road Swords

## Road Safety, Cycling and Walking Improvements

### Why is this scheme needed?

To make Seatown Road safer for everyone, particularly those walking and cycling, we are proposing cycle lanes, traffic calming and road layout improvements from the entrance to Seatown Road at Seatown Roundabout to the roundabout at the junction with Estuary Road. Works are expected to take approximately 3 months and will begin in Q3 2023.

Fingal County Council is proposing changes to reduce traffic speed and improve road safety along Seatown Road, particularly for people walking or travelling by bike by upgrading and extending existing cycle lanes along this full road length.

Whether you are heading to sport, travelling to the shops, or commuting, cycling, and walking are free, healthy, and environmentally friendly ways to travel. The proposed works are in line with a vision for active and sustainable travel that contributes to safer routes to school, supports better mental and physical health, and protects our climate by reducing carbon emissions.

### Works proposed include

- Upgrading and extending cycle lanes on both sides of the road
- Giving higher priority to those cycling and walking in the area
- Widening the footpath under the bridge to make room for those walking
- Upgrading roundabouts at Swords Business Campus and Estuary Road to cycle-friendly roundabouts with safe pedestrian crossings on all exits

### Where is the proposed work happening?

All work will take place within the area of Seatown Road starting from Seatown Roundabout and ending at the junction of Seatown Road and Estuary Road.

## Cén fáth a bhfuil gá leis an scéim seo?

Chun Bóthar Bhaile na Mara a dhéanamh níos sábháilte do chách, go háirithe iad siúd atá ag siúl agus ag rothaíocht, táimid ag moladh lánaí rothar, bearta moillithe tráchta agus feabhsuithe ar leagan amach an bhóthair ón mbealach isteach go Bóthar Bhaile na Mara ag Timpeallán Bhaile na Mara go dtí an timpeallán ag an acomhal le Bóthar an Inbhir. Táthar ag súil go dtógfaidh na hoibreacha thart ar 3 mhí agus cuirfear tús leo i R3 2023.

Tá athruithe á moladh ag Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall chun luas tráchta a laghdú agus sábháilteacht bóithre a fheabhsú feadh Bóthar Bhaile na Mara, go háirithe do dhaoine a bhíonn ag siúl nó ag taisteal ar rothair trí na lánaí rothar atá ann cheana féin a uasghrádú agus a shíneadh feadh fad an bhóthair iomlán seo.

Cibé an bhfuil tú ag dul chuig spórt, ag taisteal chuig na siopaí, nó ag comaitéireacht, is bealaí taistil saor in aisce, sláintiúil agus neamhdhíobhálach don chomhshaol iad rothaíocht agus siúl. Tá na hoibreacha molta ag teacht le fíis do thaisteal gníomhach agus inbhuanaithe a chuireann le bealaí níos sábháilte chun na scoile, a thacaíonn le sláinte mheabhrach agus fhisiciúil níos fearr, agus a chosnaíonn ár n-aeráid trí astaíochtaí carbóin a laghdú.

- Timpealláin ag Campas Gnó Shoird agus Bóthar an Inbhir a uasghrádú go timpealláin atá oiriúnach do rothair le trasrianta sábháilte do choisithe ann
