



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RAHENY CLOSE, LUSK, CO DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Raheny Close, Lusk, Co Dublin for the purpose of construction of a foul and surface water line along Raheny Close. It is proposed that the road will be closed from **24th April 2023 until the 26th of May 2023 for 24 hours per day.**

One submission was made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows, dependant on direction of travel.

Northbound and Southbound traffic – Traffic approaching the Raheny Roundabout on the Lusk R127 outer ring road will be informed in advance that Raheny Close Road is “Closed Ahead and to follow the provided diversion route”.

Travelling Southbound, continue on the ring road R127 to Remount Roundabout and take the 1st exit left onto Station Road R128 towards Rush following the diversion signs and turn left after the train station onto the L-5285 Horestone-Effelstown Road towards Tyrrellstown Big, ending the diversion route and signed as ‘End of Detour’.

Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
