STOCDA

Blanchardstown: Significant Issues.

- Operation Saul commenced at the start of last year and involves High Visibility Patrols of Train Stations and Trains with a view to tackling Anti Social Behaviour. This initiative is ongoing with a number of actions days planned for 2023
- Operation Spine Preparations are underway for St Patricks Day 2023 in order to ensure that Gardai are in a position to tackle public disorder/crime issues.
 - <u>Blanchardstown Shopping Centre -</u> Anti social Behaviour/ Crime Issues -Gardai attached to Blanchardstown have had an increased presence at the Shopping centre in recent months in order to combat issues at the centre.

Domestic Violence – our DAC (Domestic Abuse Coordinator) program is up and running with over 50 individuals being case managed and supported within the K District.

Blanchardstown: Significant Detections

- 17/1/2023 an intelligence led operation resulted in the search of an address in <u>Mulhuddart</u> and subsequent seizure of drugs valued at approximately €10,000 and €5000 cash. One male currently charged and before the courts.
- 12/1/2023 Robbery from the Person male entered Circle K had an altercation with a member of staff which became physical leaving the staff member in fear. Male identified from CCTV and arrested, detained and later charged. Matter is now before the courts.
- 22/1/2023 Dangerous Driving Vehicle containment operation put in place after a vehicle failed to stop in the Kildare division. Multiple incidents of dangerous driving in Kildare and Dublin. Vehicle made way to Blanchardstown Shopping Centre and mounted footpaths at Retail Park 2 driving along shopfronts. Vehicle was monitored by Air support. Vehicle abandoned at retail park 2 occupants ran to Whitestown Park and were apprehended by Gardai. Driver is now in Custody.

Community Engagement

- Blanchardstown Gardai continue to support the organisation Little Blue Hero's.

- Community Policing Blanchardstown are continuing to support Sonas Women's Refugee and attended the annual D15 Domestic Violence Working Group Conference where Gardai made a presentation on Coercive Control
- Foroige Community Policing Blanchardstown continue to engage and support Foroige in 2023
- Community Policing Blanchardstown are engaging with Schools and Crèches on request developing relationships with young people in D15.













UBUNTU INITIATIVE

- On 8 and 9 September 2022, <u>Dr. Ian Marder</u>, (Maynooth University <u>School of Law and Criminology</u>) co-facilitated a dialogue process in Dublin West, in collaboration with community members and Gardaí. Their goal was to explore the extent to which restorative practices could be used to facilitate dialogue and build understanding between young Black adults who live, and Gardaí who work, in D15.
- Six young Black adults and six Gardaí participated in the dialogue process. Over two days, participants engaged in a variety of discussions and other activities.
- The UBUNTU Project is funded by the Irish Research Council <u>New</u> <u>Foundations</u> scheme, and has obtained ethical approval from the Maynooth University Social Research Ethics Subcommittee.
- The results of this initiative will be published soon
