Outline of Measure

Our Rural Future is the Government's five-year strategy to revitalise rural Ireland and includes a commitment to upgrade and enhance shopfronts and street facades in our rural towns and villages. This activity will be funded by the Department of Rural & Community Development (DRCD) through the Town and Village Renewal Scheme and Fingal County Council.

Eligible Premises

Commercial, residential and community owned premises in the designated town center of Donabate

Eligible Works

- Works to individual commercial, residential and community properties.
- Eligible works include painting, signage replacement, shopfront improvement, lighting, and planting.
- Works to standalone buildings are permitted in the case of derelict buildings or vacant properties where it can be demonstrated a clear need to address the visual impact of this building on the existing streetscape.
- Murals & other public artworks subject to the agreement of Fingal County Council.

Grant Rates

Grant funding can be provided at 100% of total project costs up to a maximum of €7,200. Retrospective payments will be made once all works are completed and satisfactory evidence of completion of payments are provided as detailed in the Payment of Grant Award section below.

Completion of works

All approved works must be complete by October 28th 2023

Successful applications will require

- 1. Completed Application Form.
- 2. Required number of Quotations.
- 3. Letter of Consent from property owner if applicant does not own the property.

Payment of Grant Award will require

- Photograph of works area prior to commencement of project.
- Photograph of completed project.
- Evidence of payment i.e., bank statement extract showing payments, receipts & Invoices.
- Evidence of registration for VAT where applicable
- Tax clearance certificate for businesses/organizations.

Funding Conditions

Non-Compliance with the conditions as outlined or non-compliance with any other scheme conditions may result in the requirement to refund part or all of the grant aid awarded.

Expression of Interest Form

The Expression of interest form is detailed, and it is designed to ensure that it has the necessary information to evaluate each proposal accurately and fairly. Please ensure that you complete the expression of interest form in full and that any supporting documentation is submitted with your application.

Only projects that meet the criteria will be considered eligible.

PLEASE NOTE THAT INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS OR LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Submission of false or misleading information at any stage is treated very seriously. Any applicant who does not comply with the terms and conditions of the Programme may, subject to inspection, have their grant withdrawn, be required to repay all or part of a grant and/or be barred from making applications for a period of time.

Letter of Offer – Eligible Dates for Purchases/Works

Only purchases or work carried out <u>after</u> successful applicants receive a Letter of Offer are eligible i.e., only receipts dated after the Letter of Offer date will be accepted as eligible.

Statutory Consents

Applicants must ensure that all necessary statutory permissions or consents have been obtained before any works commence. This includes but is not confined to planning permission.

Insurance

Written evidence of a valid insurance policy may be requested, where relevant, during the applications review process.

Acknowledgment of Funding

Due to the low value of some of these grants, it would not be cost-effective to require signage acknowledging the Department of Rural & Community Development (DRCD) and Fingal County Council. Other suitable acknowledgements will suffice e.g., on a business/organization's website or social media platforms.

GDPR

To process your application, it may be necessary for Fingal County Council to collect personal data from you. Such information will be processed in line with the Local Authority's privacy statement which is available to view on the Fingal County Council website.
