



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015- SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF QUAY STREET, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Quay Street, Balbriggan, Co Dublin for the purpose of a sewer connection on behalf of Irish Water. It is proposed that the road will be **closed 24 hours each day from 13th June to the 16th June 2023.**

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

The permitted working hours are between 08:00 and 18:00 Monday to Friday and between 09:00 and 16:00 on Saturdays. No works are permitted on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows, dependant on direction of travel.

Southbound traffic: Traffic travelling south on Drogheda Street and Bridge Street follow diversions onto Hampton Street, then onto High Street and back onto Quay Street.

Northbound traffic: Traffic travelling north on Dublin Street and Bridge Street follow diversion onto Clonard Street via Fullam Street, Chapel Street back on to Drogheda Street and Bridge Street and follow diversion sign onto Quay Street.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
