



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75**

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CRESCENT ROAD RUSH, CO. DUBLIN**

An application has been received from GMC Utilities Group Limited for permission to temporarily close Crescent Road, Rush, Co Dublin for the purpose of installation of sewer and water connection on behalf of Irish Water. It is proposed that the road will be closed **21st August 2023 to 22nd August 2023 for 24 hours per day.**

The permitted working hours are between 08:00 and 18:00 Monday to Friday and between 09:00 and 16:00 on Saturdays. No works are permitted on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

**Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows, dependant on direction of travel.**

**Traffic travelling to Crescent Road Rush from West:-** Traffic travelling from South Shore Road, continue on South Shore Road, turn left onto Linkside Road and then onto Crescent Road. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

**Traffic travelling to Crescent Road Rush from East:-** Traffic travelling from South Shore Road continue onto Linkside Road, then turn left onto Crescent Road.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

**Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
