



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015– SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DOCTOR'S LANE, RUSH, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close **Doctor's Lane, Rush, Co. Dublin**. An application has now been received from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Eireann, for a further road closure to facilitate the completion of a sewer extension. The reason for this further road closure request is due to engineering difficulties and very poor ground conditions.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **2nd January 2024 to 19th January 2024 for 24 hours per day**.

No works shall take place on Saturday's, Sunday's and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows, dependant on direction of travel.

Traffic travelling to Doctor's Lane from West: Traffic travelling from Whitestown Road, continue onto Whitestown Road turn right onto Old Road. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling to Doctor's Lane from East: Traffic travelling from Old Road, continue onto Old Road, turn right onto Millbank and then onto Whitestown Road. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
