   Jugback Lane, Swords, Co. Dublin. 4 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
   Rivermeade Drive, Toberburr, St. Margaret's, Co. Dublin. 2 No. Flat Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
   Main Street, Garristown, Co. Dublin. 1 No. Bus Friendly Ramp with Zebra Crossing Road Markings.
   Seapoint, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin. 4 No. Sets Modular Traffic Calming Cushions.

The schemes provide for traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary
