Featuring live performances by young talents on both the main and busking stages, alongside music industry workshops throughout the day, it is a unique opportunity for teenage creativity to shine.

Fingal Arts Office, in collaboration with the Irish School Orchestra, have created the Orchestral Odyssey. This event has seen 3 schools in Swords host the 33-piece orchestra in their halls. It culminates on June 15th with children and their families invited to partake in an immersive experience in the newly renovated Carnegie Library on North Street, Swords.

I am super proud to be a Local Ambassador and I hope I can help other young people my age whenever possible. It really is an honour and I'm very grateful to be asked.




