Notice to Mariners 04/2024 – a boat in Skerries washed out to the beach.

The blue boat the Purdey Queen is on the beach now. Washed out to the beach couple of weeks ago, looks abandoned. The boat seems to have broken her moorings during the recent bad weather about 2 weeks ago. Unfortunately, we have no further detail as the boat owner is not a member of the sailing club and the members I have spoken to are not clear on the owner(s). The purpose of this notification on the FCC intentions might attract the owner's attention. The owner(s) of this boat are hereby required to remove this boat from the beach with an immediate affect. Otherwise the council's contractors will move this boat to Garristown Depot to keep it there some reasonable time (2 months) awaiting the owners to pay the removal and handling costs back to FCC and to collect the boat from Garristown Depot on owners account. Otherwise the boat shall disposed to a waste reception facility.
