ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE L1285 IN SKERRIES, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Global Rail Services for permission to temporarily close the L1285 in the Skerries area for the purpose of a road reinstatement. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 10.00am to 03.00pm on Thursday 15th May 2025.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Diversion route West of L1285

Traffic travelling from L1285 from West to East:- Traffic travelling west on L1285, continue north onto Golf Links Road, turn right onto Shenick Road and then right onto the R128 Rush Road. Continue south to Loughshinny. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Diversion route East of L1285

Traffic travelling from L1285/R128 from East to West:– Traffic travelling from east of the L1285, continue north on the R128 Skerries road, turn left onto Shenick Road and then left again onto Golf Links Road. Continue south onto the L1285. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
