ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 - SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURES ALONG L-5110 AND L-5105 IN THE GRACEDIEU - ROSCALL (SOUTH OF R129) AND BALHEARY TOWNLANDS (NORTH OF BALHEARY AVENUE), CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council have made an order to temporarily close along **L-5110** and **L-5105** in the **Gracedieu-Roscall (south of R129)** and **Balheary townlands (north of Balheary Ave), Co. Dublin,** that will be running concurrently for the purpose of installing ducts within roadway for Mainscourt Solar Farm grid connection. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from **26th May 2025 to 13th of June 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **07:00hrs and 22:00hrs** Monday to Friday and between **08:00hrs and 16:00hrs** on Saturdays.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

1 submission was made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Gracedieu Road from North: Travel west on R129 westbound towards Ballyboughal village, turn left onto R108 southbound, turn left onto Balheary Avenue eastbound, then left on Balheary Road northbound, and continue on Harlockstown Lane northbound.

Traffic travelling to Gracedieu Road from South: Travel south on Harlockstown Lane, then continue on Balheary Road southbound, turn right on Balheary Avenue westbound, turn right onto R108 northbound towards Ballyboughal village, then turn right onto R129 westbound.

Traffic travelling to Roscall Road from North: Travel west on L5195 Ballough-Devines Cross, turn left onto L1075 Ballyboghill-Devines Cross westbound, turn left and continue on L1075 Ballyboghill-Devines Cross southbound into Ballyboughal village, turn left onto R108 southbound, then turn left on R129 and continue to Roscall Road. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling to Roscall Road from South: Travel west on R129 towards Ballyboughal village, turn right on R108 northbound, turn right on L1075 Ballyboghill-Devines Cross northbound, turn right onto L1075 Ballyboghill-Devines Cross eastbound, then turn right onto L5195 Ballough-Devines Cross eastbound.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
