



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD BARRACK ROAD, RUSH, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from ESB Networks for permission to temporarily close **Old Barrack Road, Rush Co. Dublin** for the purpose of ESB duct installation. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 23rd of June 2025 to 28th of June 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:30hrs Monday to Friday and 09:00hrs and 16:30hrs on Saturdays.**

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

The Old Barrack Road to be closed from the junction at Bawn Road up to the junction at Lower Main Street.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Motorists travelling from Bawn road will continue to travel along Bawn Road until the intersection with Lower Main Street ending their diversion route.

Motorists travelling along Lower Main Street to be diverted to the intersection with Bawn Road.

Continuing along Bawn Road and ending their diversion route

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
