



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RED ISLAND, SKERRIES, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from TS Utilities Ltd to temporarily close **Red Island, Skerries, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of excavation works to form foundations and construct a retaining wall at the rear of a property. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 23rd of June 2025 to 11th of July 2025 from 07:00 until 18:00.**

No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Red Island Lane via the north-western entrance:

Traffic may access Red Island Lane from the north-west entrance for local access only. Advance signage will inform traffic of the roadworks and that no through-access is available.

Traffic travelling to Red Island Lane via the north-eastern entrance:

Traffic may access Red Island Lane via the north-east entrance for local access only. Advance signage will inform traffic of the roadworks and that no through-access is available.

Traffic exiting Red Island Lane:

Vehicles may exit via either entrance, depending on location. No through-traffic is possible past the excavation works.

Pedestrian access is maintained at all times from both entrances, with safety measures in place.

A section of Red Island Lane will be closed to vehicular through-traffic 24/7 due to excavation works. Local access for vehicles and pedestrians will remain available from both sides of the closure. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.

Access to Red Island is unaffected by these works.
