Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Skerries Pier, Co. Dublin Pier Partly Closed

Fingal County Council wishes to advise users of Skerries Harbour and the general public that the outer section of Skerries Pier remains closed and off-limits. Berthing against this section of the pier is currently prohibited. Galvanized fencing has been erected around the closed area of the Pier and warning signs have been placed in Irish and in English at the site also.

An Bórd Pleanála has granted planning permission for this section of the pier to be replaced, and construction will begin once all relevant licenses have been received.


