



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALHEARY ROAD, BALHEARY, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Suir Engineering for permission to temporarily close Balheary Road, Swords, Co. Dublin for the purpose of installing ducts within roadway for Mainscourt Solar Farm Grid Connection. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 14th of July 2025 to 22nd of August 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between 08:00hrs and 19:00hrs Monday to Friday.

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Balheary Road from South:

Travel south on Balheary Road, continue onto Watery Lane (R125) southbound, turn right onto R125 westbound, turn right onto R108 northbound, turn right onto Balheary Avenue eastbound and continue onto Balheary Road.

Traffic travelling to Balheary Road from North:

Travel west on Balheary Avenue, turn left onto R108 southbound, turn left on R125 eastbound, turn left onto Watery Lane northbound and continue onto Balheary Road.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion routes and road closures.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
