



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUN EMER AVENUE, LUSK CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC Utilities Ltd on behalf of Uisce Eireann for permission to temporarily close Dun Emer Avenue, Lusk, Co. Dublin for the purpose of installing a sewer connection. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 30th June 2025 to 25th July 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between 08.00 to 18.00 each day.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling eastbound from Minister's Road should continue along Minister's Road and turn right onto Kilhedge Lane. Proceed straight to the junction of Kilhedge Lane (Closure Point A). If travelling towards Dun Emer Avenue, a traffic marshal will allow residents and local access through the diverted route, which continues up Dun Emer Avenue to the closed works area, then diverts onto Dun Emer Drive, followed by Dun Emer Way, before rejoining Dun Emer Avenue.

For traffic travelling westbound from Minister's Road and turning left onto Dun Emer Avenue (Closure Point B), continue along Dun Emer Avenue until the closed area of works is reached, or follow the diversion via Dun Emer Way, onto Dun Emer Drive, and back onto Dun Emer Avenue.

Both Closure Points A and B will be manned by traffic marshals who will allow local and residential access. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
