



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LINK AND HARBOUR ROAD, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from John Cradock Ltd for permission to temporarily close Link and Harbour Road, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin for the purpose of road reconstruction and resurfacing as part of ongoing works in the area. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 16th of July 2025 to 16th of January 2026 from 08:00 to 18:00.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling from Harbour Road:

Traffic travelling from Harbour Road will not have access to Quay Street and will need to turn onto the link road and travel to Mill Street or Georges Hill to access Drogheda Street.

All Diversions will be sign posted in advance of all works

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
