



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE R-108-5; COOKS LANE JUNCTION TO KNOCKSEDAN ESTATE, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council is proposing to temporarily close the R-108-5; Cooks Lane junction to Knocksedan estate for the purpose of facilitating road surfacing works. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 21st July to 18th August 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **07:00hrs and 22:00hrs** Monday to Friday and between **08:00hrs and 16:00hrs** on Saturdays.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to R108 from North –

Traffic to continue West on R125 towards Ashbourne, then turn left onto R122 towards St Margaret's, then left onto L3132/R108 heading for Swords.

Traffic travelling to R108 from South –

Traffic to continue West on R108/L3132, then turn right onto R122 towards St Margaret's, then right onto R125 towards Swords.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
