



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF L-5070 ROAD, LISPOPPLE, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Triur Construction on behalf of Fingal County Council for permission to temporarily close L-5070 Road, Lispopple, Co. Dublin for the purpose of facilitating Lispopple Bridge Remediation. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from **18th August until 5th September 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:00hrs** Monday to Friday.

No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Travelling North:

Divert along the R125 toward Ashbourne, taking a right at Killossery onto L5061, over the Rowlestown Bridge taking a right onto Chapel Lane L-50611 heading east through Rowlestown until junction of L-5070.

Travelling South:

Divert west through Rowlestown, taking a left onto L5061, over the Rowlestown Bridge, taking a left on to R125 following the road toward Swords until junction of L-5070.

Road signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
