



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TURVEY AVENUE, DONABATE, L-2136-0 CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Turvey Avenue in Donabate for the purpose of facilitating road resurfacing works. Turvey Avenue will be closed from **Monday 14th July until Monday 28th July 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 21:00hrs** Monday to Friday.

No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays.

2 submission was made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Turvey Avenue from West towards Donabate:

Traffic to continue South on R132 towards Swords, then turn left onto R126 then left onto R126/L2170 Hearse Road. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling to Turvey Avenue from East towards R132:

Traffic travelling on R126 Hearse Road to continue South, then turn right toward Swords, then left onto R132 towards Swords and then keep left to head for R132 Balbriggan and continue R132 North. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
