NOTES

- Direction of the one-way system is subject to further design studies and development.
- Exact location, extent and configuration of traffic calming measures to be determined through further design development
- Gateways are used to demarcate a point of arrival from one place to another. They are important placemaking tools as they form the 'first impression' of a place. Gateways are also an important traffic-calming tool as they can be used to inform drivers of a change in driving conditions ahead.
- A Transition Zone refers to an area that may be needed for slowing vehicles when entering an urban area from a faster moving road, such as from a rural road into a city, town or village or from a motorway into an integrated street network.
