ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023- SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUN EMER AVENUE, LUSK CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council have made an order to temporarily close Dun Emer Avenue, Lusk, Co. Dublin for the purpose of installing a 300mm foul gravity main. It is proposed that the road will be closed from 1st September 2025 to 10th October for 24 hours per day.

Permitted working hours shall be between 08.00 to 18.00 each day.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic coming from Minister's Road should continue along Minister's Road and turn right onto Kilhedge Lane. Proceed straight to the junction of Kilhedge Lane (Closure Point A). If Travelling in the direction of Dun Emer Avenue, a traffic marshal will allow residents and local access through the diverted route which continues up Dun Emer Avenue until the closed works area (From outside house 24), which is then diverted onto Dun Emer Drive and then onto Dun Emer Way before coming out onto the other side of Dun Emer Avenue.

For traffic coming from Ministers Road and turning left onto Dun Emer Avenue (Closure Point B). Continue along Dun Emer Avenue until the Closed area of works is reached adjacent to house number 35 or the diverted route takes you along Dun Emer Way and onto Dun Emer Drive and then continues onto Dun Emer Avenue.

Both closure points A&B will be manned by a traffic marshal who will allow local/residential access. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
