



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**

### **PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE BETWEEN PORTRANE ROAD AND BEAVERSTOWN ROAD, DONABATE, CO. DUBLIN**

An application has been received from Fingal County Council's Active Travel Department for permission to temporarily close the link road between **Portrane Road and Beaverstown Road, Donabate, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of facilitating a temporary creation of a "School Street" as part of European Mobility week. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 16th September until 22nd September 2025 from 08:00 to 17:00**.

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

#### **Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:**

The closure will affect the link road connecting the Portrane Road and Beaverstown Road. This road provides access to St. Michael's House, Gaelscoil na Mara, the Donabate Portrane Community Centre, and Donabate Community College.

#### **Traffic travelling Northbound:**

The northbound lane will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. However, pedestrian, cycling, and scooting access will be maintained and permitted to use the closed lane.

#### **Traffic travelling Southbound:**

Vehicular access will be facilitated via the southbound lane, which will remain open and accessible from Beaverstown Road only.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

**Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
