



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNLEIGH GREEN, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN.**

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Thornleigh Green, Swords, Co. Dublin for the purpose of facilitating a temporary creation of a “School Street” as part of European Mobility week. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from **16th September until 22nd September 2025 from 08:00 to 08:30 and 12:00 to 14:15.**

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

2 submissions were made during the consultation process.

**Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:**

**Traffic travelling along Thornleigh Green heading North:**

Traffic will turn right at Applewood Main Street then take a left onto Thornleigh Road, take a left onto Thornleigh Green and a right onto Thornleigh Square.

**Traffic travelling along Thornleigh Green heading South:**

Traffic will turn left onto Thornleigh Green, take a right onto Thornleigh Road then a right onto Applewood Main Street and finally a left onto Thornleigh Green.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

**Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
